



Firefighter Paramedic

Durango Fire Protection District (DFPD) believes that hiring qualified individuals to fill positions contributes to the overall strategic success of DFPD. Each employee, while employed, is hired to make significant contributions to DFPD.

We are currently taking applications for **Firefighter/Paramedic**. Multiple full-time positions are available for a Firefighter/Paramedic. Starting hourly rate for Firefighter/Paramedic is \$23.50/hr, depending on experience, plus FLSA, holiday pay, and benefits.

Minimum Qualifications to apply: High School Diploma or GED, Firefighter 1 certification or higher (or equivalent), Hazmat Operations certification, Colorado Paramedic license or NREMT-P, NWCG S-130, S-190, and L-180, a valid driver's license and ability to work 24 hour shifts.

To be considered for the testing process the following items are due by **May 27, 2024, at 1600 hours**.

1. Application for Employment – all sections completed
2. Resume and Cover Letter
3. Copy of certifications verifying current Firefighter 1, HazMat Operations, Colorado Paramedic, and NWCG S-130/S-190/L-180.

The testing process will consist of a written test including firefighting questions and EMS questions, an EMS and Firefighter skills assessment, and an oral interview. **The testing process will take place on Tuesday, June 4th.**
