

## Testing for: EMT, Paramedic & Firefighter/EMS

Durango Fire Protection District (DFPD) believes that hiring qualified individuals to fill positions contributes to the overall strategic success of DFPD. Each employee, while employed, is hired to make significant contributions to DFPD.

We are currently taking applications for **Firefighter/Medics – EMT, EMT-A, EMT-I or Paramedic**. We have full-time positions available for Firefighter/Paramedic(s) and part-time positions for all Firefighter/EMT levels and EMT only.

## Minimum Qualifications to apply:

**Emergent Response:** High School Diploma or GED, Firefighter 1 certification or higher (or equivalent), Hazmat Operations certification, Colorado EMT or higher, NWCG S-130, S-190, and L-180, a valid driver's license and ability to work 24 hour shifts.

**Non-Emergent Response:** High School Diploma or GED, Colorado EMT or higher, a valid driver's license and ability to work 12 hour shifts.

To be considered for the testing process the following items are due no later than **Monday**, **June 17<sup>th</sup>**, **2024 at NOON MDT.** 

- 1. Application for Employment all sections completed

- 2. Resume and cover letter
- 3. Copy of certifications

Completed application packets may be returned either in person to Megan or electronically to <u>megan.kunch@durangofire.org</u>.

The testing process will depend on level of certification and the job being applied for but could consist of a written test including firefighting questions and EMS questions, an EMS and Firefighter skills assessment and an oral interview. The testing process will take place on **Monday, June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2024**.
